Victorian Stick Style

**T**he Sterrett Victorian Stick Style home was built by David Sterrett, noted Smethport attorney, in 1872. By 1890 the property had been acquired by Henry and Hannah Hamlin who sold it to John and Sarah Shoemaker.

In 1891 attorney John Nevin Apple purchased the home.

The house has remained in the Apple family for over 115 years. The dining room has eight doors framed in golden oak and is decorated with wainscoting of the same pattern.
