William Specht, dealer in furniture & undertaker, immigrated from Hanover, Germany in 1851, and the same year settled in Smethport. In 1879 he and Carl Sasse, his half-brother & business partner erected the Specht & Sasse Furniture And Undertaking building at 133 W. Main Street.
